

Baypoint Preparatory Academy - San Diego Admissions Policy

Based on the need in San Marcos and the surrounding community for an educational option, BPA-SD will focus and prioritize recruitment and enrollment of all students in the San Marcos Community. If the number of pupils who wish to attend BPA-SD exceeds the school's capacity, attendance, except for existing pupils of the charter school, shall be determined by a public random drawing. Preference shall be extended to students currently attending BPA-SD and students who reside in the District. During any period of funding for the Public Charter Schools Grant Program and continuing through the term of the charter, this admissions preference will be given a 2:1 weighting factor or as otherwise agreed upon with SMUSD during the single weighted public drawing. No other admissions exemptions or preferences will be assigned. The BPA-SD Governing Board may review this preference policy as necessary for the well-being of the school.
