Dear Parent/Guardian,

For the 2023-24 school year, Baypoint will offer ELOP after-school program. With targeted guidance from teachers and academic coaches, ELOP (Theme: Garden by the Bay) will provide academic tutoring infused with STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) and physical activities. This program will support and strengthen the students' knowledge/skill set by addressing the post-Covid and summer learning loss.

Baypoint is mandated to offer ELOP in grades TK/K-6. As a priority, Baypoint is mandated to offer ELOP to <u>all current and new unduplicated student populations</u> (English Learners, socio-economically disadvantaged, foster youth, and homeless students). The remaining spots will be offered to all students who don't qualify as unduplicated in TK/K-8 grades based on time-stamped response to this registration, and if necessary, your child will be placed on the waitlist.

ELOP is offered on a first-come/first-served basis, contingent upon available ratios and available space. Low attendance and excessive late pick-ups will result in student withdrawal from the program.



If you are interested in the ELOP after-school program, please register your child as soon as possible (a separate registration email was sent via Parent Square).

The ELOP registration will be closed on Wednesday, August 16th at 4:00 PM.

Baypoint procedures and expected student conduct listed in the BPA-SD Student/Parent Handbook will apply to the ELOP program.

Since the theme of the program will be "Garden by the Bay," your child may bring a change of clothes for gardening activities only. More information will be forthcoming.
