- a. Recent Amendment on the Assembly Floor currently for a vote. Can really harm non-classroom based schools. Will triple the current cap on authorizer oversight fees. Ours is currently 1 percent but ours could currently raise ours to 3 percent. Huge fiscal impact to Charter Schools. Removes school choice with parents. Frank encouraged the board to reach the legislature. Starts with non-classroom based schools but we shouldn't ignore it because it can very well be Charter Schools next. Completely compromises parent choice to choose a Charter School. Prohibit funding outside of the student's home county.
